1	Mr. Abdul Qadeer Khan	Father of Pakistani Atomic Program

- He was Born in Bhopal India in 1936 and died recently on 10TH Oct. 2021.
- He had been awarded with Nishan e Pakistan, Hilal e Pakistan on his Contribution.
- He founded Khan Research Laboratory in 1976 (KRL)
- He also known as Mohsin e Pakistan

2	Mr. Abdus Salam	Wiiner of Nobel Prize in Physics

- He was born in 29th January 1926, in Jhang, Punjab and died on 21st November 1996.
- He was Theoretical Physicist.
- He won Nobel Prize in 1979 on [electroweak unification](#) theory.
- He was first Pakistani and first muslim to won prize in the field of Science.



- He was the founding director of the Space and Upper Atmosphere Research Commission (SUPARCO),

- Pervaiz is a strong supporter for peaceful civilian-used nuclear technology in Pakistan whereas he is also supervising the construction of second atomic power plant, Karachi nuclear power plant-II, in Karachi.
